NEWS

• The Chinese Community (Carol's group) held a cultural event last Sunday in the Yangebup Community Hall. Gizella attended and advised that this was a well organised and enjoyable event hosted by the Chinese Community. Carol estimated that there was about 400 people who attended.

 Meski has been working on the development of the Cultural Diversity and Inclusion Plan. A launch is being planned to advise the community of what's included in the plan. Meski has agreed to send the draft plan to Sam and Belinda.

PROGRESS

- Citizen Ceremony can CCK attend? This would be a great opportunity to promote the celebrate culture group and welcome people into Australia. Meski has agreed to seek permission if CCK can attend the larger ceremonies to promote CCK. Flyers of future events and information will be promoted by Meski at the ceremonies.
- Resource List is there a list or directory of all the cultural groups in Cockburn? Or a resource list of activities/services/facilities/amenities in Cockburn? This question has been raised at nearly all our action team meetings. There is a resource list, Meski advised that it's not yet community friendly, CoC library do have a service list which is update regularly. A copy of the resource list is to be sourced from the library by Belinda.
- Results of CoC for Cockburn Creates Yangebup Family Centre have been fully funding for social toy box and the STEM (Science, technology, engineering, maths) for girls. STEM and the Social Toy boxes will be launched in November, Sam will provide details and flyers at the long table lunch.
 - > STEM will start in the January school holidays and will run during term 1. Meerilinga will host STEM in the April school holidays and it will continue to run during term 2;
 - ➤ Social toy box this is a box of sandpit toys that will be left in local parks sandpits for the children to play with. Yangebup will meet with the CoC to determine which parks. Yangebup have been funded for 8 boxes, they will do 4 this year and the other 4 next year. There will be signage on the box providing the community of the background information and rules of the box. Community are welcome to donate sandpit toys.

- CoC will supply the cement for the Street Libraries, it's the Centres responsibility to organise installation of the Street Library into the ground
- Bunnings Belinda has agreed to contact Bunnings to see if they would be interested in rolling this initiative out to the community in 2019
- Once the boxes are secured into the ground the Street Libraries website will be updated with the location
- What Next? It would be great if this initiative could be rolled out in WA, then eventually reach the whole of Australia.
