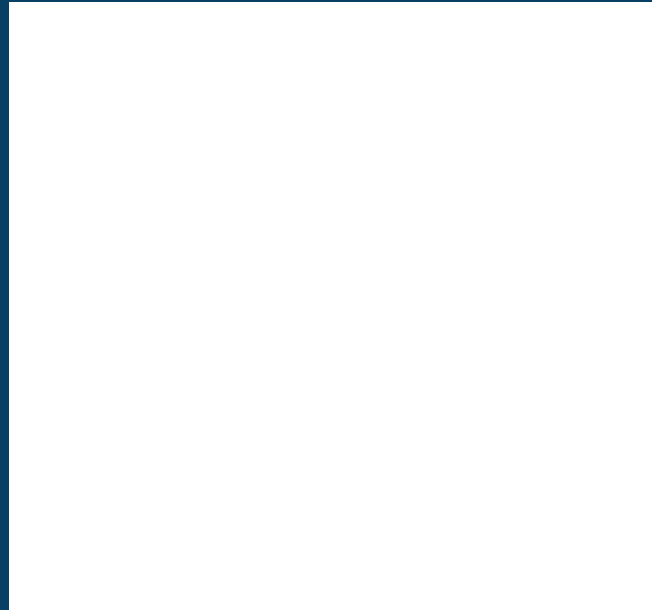

Welcome to our Playgroup

Your playgroup has partnered with Connecting Community for Kids (CCK) to run a weekly playgroup for children aged 0-5 years of all abilities to play in an inclusive safe space.

A family mentor from CCK will attend each playgroup to help support and provide opportunities for inclusion. Our goal is to help support families with disabilities to access the playgroup.

How we can support you

CCK is a collective impact initiative that brings community together to improve well-being and development of children.

Even if you or your child don't identify as having a disability, our family mentor can help connect you to community and opportunities to support the development of your child.

It will be business as usual for families to enjoy their groups as they normally do. Our family mentors will provide information and additional sensory activities which you are welcome to take part in.
